My Lord,

I have the honour to refer to a despatch addressed to Your Lordship by the British High Commissioner, Constantinople, No. 1068/M/2049 of June 25th, and also to his despatch to me No. M.2049 of the same date enclosing the originals of two letters addressed by El Sayed Ahmed el Sherif el Senoussi to General Maxwell and El Sayed Mohammed el Sherif of Cairo.
